Topography: Topography means the nature and formation of the land, especially its height.

Hilly area: A hilly area where has many hills.

Location of hilly areas of Bangladesh: There are some hills in Bangladesh.

- 1.Some hills are located in the south-east and north-west regions of Bangladesh.
- 2. The hills of south-east are located in the district of Khagrachari, Rangamati, Bandarban and Chittagong.

The highest peak of Bangladesh:

- 1. Tazin Dong is the highest peak of Bangladesh.
- 2.It's height is 1280 metres.
- 3.It is located in Bandarban.

The second highest peak of Bangladesh:

- 1. Keokradong is the second highest peak of Bangladesh.
- 2.It's height is 1230 metres.
- 3.It is also located in Bandarban.

High land:Below hilly areas are areas of high land with old alluvial soil

where silt was deposited from rivers long ago.

Plains: A plain is a broad area of relatively flat land. The plains have new alluvial soil and slop down from north to south. Many rivers flow through these plains and they are often flooded, so the land formed with new alluvial soil, is very fertile.
