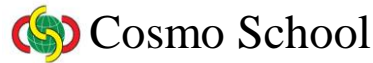

1. Weather is the condition of a particular area for short period.	1. Climate is the average result of many years weather of an area.

Weather changes every day. We never see the same weather every day. Weather changes for various reasons. But the change of temperature and airflow are mainly responsible for the weather change.

When the sun rises in the morning, air becomes warmer and temperature goes up. When the sun sets, the air becomes cooler and temperature goes down. These temperature changes are called as diurnal change. Due to the sun's position in the sky these changes occur.

Wind cause weather changes. For example, cloud of a certain area is blown to other area by wind. Wind also moves clouds from the sky and make it clear Winds are formed when the Sun heats up some parts of the earth more strongly than others, and the difference in temperature makes the air move. Sometimes the weather can be very powerful, bringing violent storms or cyclones.
