Topic: Clause and its Type

1. Write definition with 2 examples of the following topic.

Clause:

A clause is a set of words containing a subject and a predicate.

Example:

- a. He plays cricket regularly.
 - Sub. Predicate
- b. He is a wise man.
 - Sub. Predicate

Main Clause

The clause which expresses a complete meaning and can stand alone as a sentence, is called main clause.

Example:

- a. I saw a man.
- b. Teacher asked me some question.

Subordinate Clause

The clause which cannot express a complete meaning and cannot stand alone as a sentence, is called subordinate clause. It depends on the main clause to complete its meaning.

Example:

- a. When I was five
- b. Since it's raining
