- 1. What is called Al-Isra?**
Answer Prophet's (sm) journey at night to Jerusalem called "Al-Isra",
- 2. What is Al meraj?**
Answer Prophet's (sm) an ascent to heaven in the same night called "Al-Miraj"
- 3. When Prophet (sm) did go to Meraj?**
Answer 10th year of his prophethood 27 Rojob Prophet (sm) went to Meraj
- 4. What was most remarkable event for Prophet (Sm)?**
Answer Meraj was most remarkable event for Prophet (Sm).
- 5. Who did awake him from his sleep?**
Answer Angel Jibrail awoke him from his sleep.
- 6. Where did Angel Jibrail took him?**
Answer Angel Jibrail took him to Al-Masjidul Aksa at Jerusalem.
- 7. Where is the Al Masjidul Aksa situated?**
Answer Al Masjidul Aksa is situated at Jerusalem

Answer Muhazirs means emigrants
- 12. Who are called Muhazirs?**
Answer Those who migrated from Makkah to Madina are called 'Muhazirs'
- 13. Who are called Ansar?**
Answer Those who gave shelter at Madina and rendered help and co-operation are called 'Ansars'
- 14. What is the meaning of Ansars?**
Answer Ansar means helper
- 15. When did Prophet (sm) entered into Madina /migrated to Madina?**
Answer On 24 September, 622 A.D.
