Preposition:

Prepositions are words we use to show the relationship of noun or pronoun to other words in a sentence. Prepositions can be called **Place Words** because they often tell us the position of things.

Example: The puppy is **on** the chair.



The girl is **beside** the chair



The cat is **under** the chair.



The prepositions **On**, **Beside and Under** all refer to the noun **Chair**. They tell us the relationship between it and the Puppy, the Girl and the Bone.

Types of Preposition:

There are different types of prepositions. They are:



- 1. Prepositions of Time
- 2. Prepositions of Place

Prepositions of Time:



Preposition of Time are words that refer time. Common Preposition of Time are: In, On, At etc.

Prepositions of Time: In, On, At We use "In" before months, years, seasons and long period of In time. Jan Feb Mar Before any Month (In January, In Jun Jul Aug February etc.) Oct Before any Season (In Summer, In Spring etc.) Before time period (in the morning/ evening/ afternoon) Good afternoon! Good Evening o morning Before years and centuries (In 2020, In 20 Century) We use "On" before days and dates. On



• Before any Weekdays (On Saturday, On Sunday etc.)



 Before any dates (On 4 July, On 31 January, 2018 etc.)



• Before any occasion and holiday (on his birthday, on Eid Day, on Christmas Day etc.)







At

We use "At" to refer specific time.

- at 5 o' clock
- at 11.30 am etc.



- at lunchtime
- at the moment etc.



• at night / midnight / noon







• at sunrise / sunset
